- a) Distinguish between rural gentrification and rural fragmentation. 4pts
- b) Describe and give reasons for the unequal impact of spatial reconfiguration on rural areas in more economically developed countries. 6pts

Grade descriptions for your response:

1pt: response essentially copied from document.

2-3pts: response shows an attempt by the student to describe the different forms of spatial reconfiguration in more economically developed countries, it may offer superficial reasons.

4-6pts: sophisticated response which describes and explains in more detail the reasons for these differences developing on the ideas stated in the PowerPoint.

- c) Use the Rural-Urban Continuum Model. Describe what happens to villages with increased distance from a large city. You should try to show understanding of the concepts of greenbelt, overspill town, remote villages and second homes in your response. 6pts

Grade descriptions for your response:

1-2pt: response essentially copied from information on the document.

3-4pts: response shows an attempt by the student to describe the changes to village settlements with distance from large towns and the student will also attempt, possibly without being entirely successful, to show understanding of the concepts.

5-6pts: sophisticated response which describes and explains changes to villages and shows an understanding of the concepts to offer reasons.

- d) Explain why urban sprawl has led to rural fragmentation in more economically developed countries. 4pts
