Evaluation Criteria

- **0-8 pts: superficial responses** written in a poor or simplistic level of knowledge / copied from document.
- 9-12 pts: responses demonstrate **reasonable level of understanding** in a satisfactory level of English, errors will be noticeable. Candidate should give some reasons for their choice of responses to questions 3 and 4. Question 5 is likely to be a simple description with some reasons given.
- 13-16 pts: Good level of English throughout the responses, answers to questions 3 and 4 provide a justification of the candidate's choice (not simply a list of reasons). Response to Question 5 will be competent though likely to be limited by candidate's level of English.
- 17-20pts: Excellent and detailed responses to all questions. Candidate will comprehensively justify their responses to questions 3, 4 and 5 in a sophisticated level of English language expression.
